



VSNA Outstanding Women's Award 2017

1. To receive this award, the nominee shall have rendered exemplary service in preserving, propagating and protecting the principles and practice of the Veerashaiva way of life, legacy and heritage in the subcontinent of North America.
2. To be eligible to be nominated for this award, an individual shall have served with distinction the VSNA at the National Level for at least five years, in particular in organizing children's and women's activities, inspiring and motivating her peers to reach the unreachable in the cause of and on behalf of the VSNA. The nomination for this coveted honor shall be forwarded by Chapter President to the VSNA's BOD and shall have to be endorsed by the Chair of the VSNA's BOR.
3. The nomination shall be accompanied by a brief resume of the honoree, a brief but documented evidence of the outcome of the service to the Veerashaiva community at large of North America and to the VSNA itself.
4. Direct or indirect canvassing by the candidate for the award shall automatically result in disqualification.
5. Nominations should be made by at least by two good standing VSNA members who are not related to the nominee.
