Path Forward - VSNA Bylaw Violations (Alleged) by Mrs. Nayantara Swamy, Past BOR Chair

Sharanu,

We received written notification from the VSNA Election Committee (EC) and a formal request to the board to verify and take appropriate actions regarding Bylaw Violations by Mrs. Nayantara Swamy, past BOR chair. In response, VSNA Treasurer conducted Discovery and Analysis and provided the Verification Report, with evidence and facts for the board and key community leaders. We also solicited suggestions and recommendations from the board and other senior leaders of the community to find an amicable solution while keeping the integrity of VSNA in the forefront.

As officers, we are in a "No Win" situation with respect to VSNA Bylaw violations by Mrs. Navantara Swamy, past BOR Chair. The recommendations and suggestions received vary significantly and leave us in a very difficult situation to find a path forward. After detailed discussions and evaluation of the recommendations received, we have arrived at the following actions to be taken:

- 1. VSNA Bylaw Violation #1 (Alleged) Casting the second vote in VSNA Elections knowing the fact that she was not eligible to vote (Article III Corporation Member, Section 1(C) Eligibility to Vote): Swamy family paid the new life membership dues by check dated Sept 20th, 2022, which was deposited on Oct 3rd, 2022. For the voluntary action taken by her, blaming others, and claiming that she should not have received two ballots from EC as her defense is very weak. As the top adviser of VSNA, Past BOR Chair, and having quided EC and Officers for decades about adhering and respecting the VSNA Bylaws, she needs to accept responsibility for her own action.
 - Path forward: The EC has already considered this vote as invalid and this violation by Mrs. Swamy has no effect on the outcome of elections. Hence, we request Mrs. Swamy to write to EC acknowledging her error and accept their decision to ignore the second ballot by Jan 22nd, 2023.
- 2. VSNA Bylaw Violations #2 (Alleged) As her new Life Membership starts from Oct 3rd, 2022, she is not eligible to hold any VSNA office until Oct 2nd, 2023 (Article VII Board of Regents, Section I (a) Eligibility): All the evidence, facts and arguments presented clearly casts a cloud of suspicion with respect to the new Life Membership of Mrs. Nayantara Swamy. As per the records, Mr. Mallikariuna Swamy was the known listed member for decades and he cannot have a second life membership. Hence, Mrs. Navantara Swamy has been awarded the second membership. After the fact, she is requesting to reverse this action claiming that she was the main listed life member. Arguments against or for this related counterclaim become a matter of opinion and a very weak defense at best. Strictly as per Bylaw, she cannot hold any office until Oct 2nd, 2023, and at the same time, we also recognize that she was eligible before acquiring this new independent life membership and cannot deny her long service provided to VSNA organization in various capacities.
 - a. Path forward: In similar situations, many officers have voluntarily relinquished their positions in the past and the board also attempted to suspend a past president. Hence, it is left to the conscience of Mrs. Navantara Swamy whether to uphold her strong advocacy of strictly adhering to VSNA Bylaws to others and applying it to herself. If she doesn't take any voluntary action by Jan 22nd. 2023, we will cancel her new life membership and transfer the membership amount as a donation to the Convention Trust

While being aware that the above actions partially satisfy our board and community leaders, keeping the future of VSNA Organization, we have tried to find a balanced path forward. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

VSNA President & Chair introduced the office bearers of Central VSNA and the agenda for the meeting. He suggested to the members to listen to the reports of the Secretary and Treasurer and then to begin a questions and discussions session allowing ample time. He stressed that all questions should be engaged in a positive manner by raising hand, and one person speaking at one time to allow him to conduct the meeting professionally.

VSNA Secretary Report

Esteemed members of the General Body,

It is with great pleasure and gratitude that I stand before you today as the Secretary of the VSNA, to present the Secretary's report and share the significant contributions and achievements of our dedicated team. Over the past two and a half years, we have witnessed remarkable growth and expansion in the VSNA organization, and it is a testament to the collective effort and dedication of each member.

One of our proudest accomplishments is the expansion of VSNA chapters. We have added two new chapters, VSNA San Antonio and VSNA Alberta in 2021, followed by VSNA Austin and VSNA Indiana in 2022. In the past six months alone, we have welcomed VSNA Minnesota to our family. We are also actively working on establishing two sharana groups in Washington State and Ottawa, Canada. With these additions, our total number of chapters has reached 29, and we are on the verge of crossing the milestone of 30. With your support and active participation, we can strive to have a chapter in each state, mirroring the map of America itself.

The 45th Sharana Samanvaya Convention held in Houston stands as a remarkable achievement for our organization. Despite the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Central VSNA took the bold step of assuming full financial responsibility for the convention, in the absence of a host chapter. This decision proved to be a resounding success, both in terms of the convention itself and its financial outcome. Through generous donations and cost-effective planning, we were able to pay back \$36,000 to the VSNA Convention Trust Fund. The total amount distributed reached \$52,000, with an additional \$25,000 in donations pledged for the CTF during the convention. These savings of nearly \$75,000 are a testament to the dedicated efforts of our Fundraising Chair, Kavya Hiremath, and the unwavering support of Houston Chapter Convention Chair, Anuradha Gubbi. This model of Central VSNA taking financial responsibility and working with voluntary support from a smaller chapter can serve as an example for future endeavors.

AGENDA ITEM:

VSNA Annual General Body Members - Discussions

Q: Mrs. Uma Sajjan, Pennsylvania Chapter: Recommended a printed copy of financial statement to be provided to the AGM and requested an email copy to be provided to all the board and life members. She also asked for clarification on legal fees being paid for ongoing Mr. Hadimani Defamation litigation.

A: VSNA President acknowledged the suggestions made and provided clarification that financial statements have been made available to all BOD/BOR/CPs and the same can be distributed to all the Life members of the respective chapters.

A: VSNA President provided a detailed overview of the causes of the current Litigation starting from the VSNA Bylaw Recount legal case filed by nearly twenty Past Presidents and Senior Life Members of VSNA around mid-2020. He explained the pressure on VSNA Treasurer and him as soon as they took over the administration in Feb 2021 to provide the VSNA Bylaw Voting Details demanded by Michigan Court. By March 2021, the Bylaw changes were dismissed by the court due to the evidence of fraud in the voting process by the system administrator, Mr. Hadimani. During mid-2021, VSNA BOD and BOR passed the unanimous resolutions to remove the Past President Mr. Hadimani from primary membership of VSNA. Current VSNA President was responsible to execute actions in line with the unanimous resolutions of the board and to safeguard the interests of VSNA. In Aug 2021, a legal notice demanding \$250K was sent to him for his actions taken as the VSNA President. VSNA board nearunanimously approved the resolution to engage a lawyer to defend VSNA and its interests as per the indemnification bylaws. After obtaining the formal VSNA Board approval, officers signed the contract with an Attorney Office to defend VSNA interests and worked hard to provide all the details needed for the litigation. In Dec 2021, the legal case was dismissed by the District Court of Harris County, Texas penalizing Mr. Hadimani up to \$11, 250. In Jan 2022, the case was further appealed by Mr. Hadimani in the Court of Appeals, Texas for reconsideration. Currently, the court of appeals has sent the case back to the lower court for further investigation. The continuation of this legal case completely depends on the future actions of Mr. Hadimani and VSNA will just continue to defend. He requested the general body members to provide any suggestions or better solutions to the current legal situation and assured that VSNA officers are open to consider their input.

Q: Mr Guruswamy Ayya from Florida Chapter asked the VSNA President whether he has met or spoken to Mr. Hadimani any time?

A: VSNA President responded that he has never met Mr. Hadimani in person and never had any previous relationship of any kind. He mentioned that he had spoken to him only once around mid-2019 regarding the changes being made to Mission, Goals and Objectives of VSNA Bylaws.

Q: Mr. Susheela Viruppanavar from Detroit Chapter enquired about records of life memberships and wanted clarification on recent fake emails circulated.

A: VSNA President Harish responded about measures being taken around the life memberships and new website development under consideration which will help in keeping membership records always updated, and importantly when records are passed on from one committee to the next committee. He also mentioned the fake email circulated in the name of Prabhu Patil, Past President, to discredit the VSNA Officers claiming that they are destroying the organization to satisfy their personal ego. He also mentioned that Prabhu Patil has responded identifying the email as fake and requesting us to ignore it.

Subsequent Discussions & Comments by members:

VSNA Treasurer, Bhavani, further provided an explanation on efforts undertaken by the website development team.

Somashekar from Pittsburg chapter mentioned the ordeal about losing track of life membership paid for family members.

Guru Bale from NY/NJ Chapter provided an explanation on how documents are lost in transition from one committee to another. He indicated that there's a need to print out financial report and make it available to the GB.

Gadigeppa Doddamani from Detroit Chapter mentioned his awareness of the life membership situation and mentioned that members also have personal responsibility in maintaining the records at their end, and not always rely on officers in a voluntary organization.

Nagabhushan Mallakla from Central California Chapter shed light about disconnect between local chapter and Central VSNA. And lack of communication that flows between members of local chapters and the central VSNA. He suggested considering a split of annual membership, so that local chapter remains committed in making VSNA successful.

Amrutesh Shivachar from Houston Chapter also pointed out the need for the life member lists integrity and mentioned his details have been accurate for many years. He also suggested creating a Whatsapp Group of Life Members of VSNA.

Dilip Shivanna from Georgia Chapter offered his help with fixing the VSNA Life Members; he pointed out a big bottleneck with chapter presidents not sharing VSNA information with its members and not providing Central VSNA updates.

Somashekar Palegar from Florida Chapter requested resending of his Life Membership Certificate

Kusuma Aralere from Virginia & DC Chapter indicated being part of the website committee led by Bhavani, narrated specific instances of Life Members not receiving VSNA information.

VSNA Legal Case Update

The defamation case was dismissed by the District Court and Hadimani was fined up to \$11, 500. Hadimani had approached the Texas Court of Appeal to review the lower court verdict. The Court of Appeal has requested the District Court to conduct more investigation before reaching the verdict. He mentioned that officers have discussed the current situation with the VSNA Attorneys and solicited their help to update the board. He shared the email from VSNA Attorneys explaining the current situation in layman terms to the board.

In the email, VSNA Attorney has mentioned that the case has now come back to lower court for further investigation and will inform VSNA as soon as he hears from the lower court. The costs associated with the appeal (\$166.00) need to be paid depending on the final outcome of the case in the lower court.

Due to the Attorney Client Confidentiality agreement, the chair mentioned that all the future information to the board will be shared by written emails from the VSNA attorney. He also mentioned that VSNA Attorneys are concerned about the confidentiality of the information shared with the board and requested all the board members to maintain STRICT CONFIDENTIALITY. To safeguard the interests of VSNA, he directed all the board members to avoid sharing or discussing the details outside the board.

47th VSNA Convention hosting update

Harish mentioned that no one had come forward to host the next 47th VSNA Convention. Shilpa from Ohio mentioned it would be difficult for their chapter to host given only 16 families. Harish further explored by providing the option of full financial responsibility by Central VSNA and local chapter supporting by volunteers and logistics arrangements, such as hospitality and food. Shilpa responded it would be difficult to find volunteers.

Jay Jayadev mentioned the need to have multiple plans, discussions summarized below.

He suggested creating "Central Convention Committee". When no local chapter is forthcoming to host the annual convention, this CCC will pick up responsibility to conduct the convention. The idea would be to pick 4-5 major touristy destinations such as NY, Chicago, Orlando etc. and these locations could be rotated, while local chapters provide support as needed. Jay further elaborated that of the many convention committees that would be needed, these could be assigned to each Chapter President to lead and take responsibility, and this would boost the attendance as well. He took the example of today's meeting where the attendance is only 9 people and expressed his concerns.

Harish responded by agreeing with Jay's thoughts and indicated he attended the recent NAVIKA event in Austin and made parallels. Bhavani concurred but pointed out getting the CCC would be the bottleneck.

Nanda M mentioned that they hosted the convention only few years ago and they have not considered conducting the next convention. But she mentioned she would discuss it with her committee and get back.

Sujatha from Florida mentioned they are not interested, given proximity to Atlanta which hosted this year convention.

Harish indicated if there are no takers, then another option would be to run a virtual annual convention. As many are suggesting having Onsite Convention once in two year, we may rotate one year Virtual (online) and next year Onsite. .

Bhavani opined that every year begging of some chapter to conduct the convention along with going to the same set of sponsors to donate should be avoided.

Jay suggested calling for an emergency board meeting, picking a city, and deploy the CCC concept. He mentioned each time annual convention is held, there is invariably splits that occur and this option would mitigate all bickering, provide CCC to lead, and given all guidelines related to the conduct of the convention is already documented and available, this would align to the Samanvaya concept.

Harish agreed with Jay's thoughts and discussion ended with decision to explore the formation of CCC.

AGENDA ITEM:

VSNA Convention Updates

Harish provided 45th convention update. He elaborated on the financial success and mentioned again, that finance support is not a problem is conduct of convention, joining of participants is a challenge.

VSNA 45th Sharana Samanvaya Convention Financial Report has been attached to this Minutes of Meeting.

Following the presentation, Harish brought forward a resolution related to the convention finances.

Next, Jay provided update on 46th convention He appreciated Harish et al for providing a lot of support, thanked the Central VSNA and mentioned how everyone worked together for the convention. There were differences minor in nature and thanked all GA members. He mentioned there was only one medical emergency during the event related to personal health. He also mentioned the key highlight was NEXTGEN who engaged and enjoyed the convention. He mentioned even detractors had provided appreciation for the successful convention. He concluded by thanking members again.

AGENDA ITEM:

VSNA International Dasoha Day and VCTF update and support from Chapter Presidents

Harish provided a brief update on the conduct of international Dasoha day. First time, great turn up with many chapters participating and submitting the reports. Next year, our intent is to start early.

Regarding VCTF, he mentioned for VCTF there were already 70-80 already registered. Harish encouraged chapter presidents to take active role, the event is not about winning or losing although close \$5K was set aside for prize monies. Preparing the videos and sending, education within the families are important considerations. Encouraged chapter presidents to make sure kids register and participate in the VCTF 2023.

AGENDA ITEM:

VSNA Chapter Election Process

Harish reminded chapter election process. Back in December an email was circulated which again laid out requirements per bylaws. The process is essentially the same as Central VSNA. He further iterated that come Jan. of next year, each Board member needs to become life or annual member of the organization.

Jay suggested that annual members of local chapters should be deemed annual members of the Central VSNA. Bhavani clarified extra \$25 is to be collected by the local chapter and this needs to be transferred to central VSNA. Local chapters also need to provide the information of such members, but this is not followed. Bhavani also recalled an instance when a local chapter looked for voting ballots for its annual members when information was not shared with central VSNA.

Harish further expanded on this agenda item by emphasizing that when it comes to local chapter elections, the role of central VSNA is to ensure compliance, but not to interfere or influence the outcome of the election process.

Harish said 80% of the time local election process is not a problem but indicated there are instances where local chapter members have felt their local chapters are controlled by small group of people and this should not be happening. He encouraged following transparent and democratic processes.

Jay shared GA election process as an example. His term will end in December and has asked for selfnominations to be sent to an elected senior member in the community. If there are more than one person interested in the same position, then there may be some negotiations to avoid elections. If not, elections need to be conducted by soliciting secret electronic ballots or mail-in ballots from all the paid members. Harish suggested to avoid the elections as many members don't take losing in the elections constructively.

AGENDA ITEM:

VSNA Website development

Bhavani provided a brief update that website development proposals are being received. One proposal from India, Greenbots was too high and another company from Indiana will submit within one week. Plan is to bring either all three vendors or select one via the website committee and bring to board to finalize. Currently, at least \$10K is set aside for website development.

Hadimani Defamation Case against VSNA: Harish updated that Harris County District Court has proceeded with scheduling and docket control and the trial date has been set for April 1st, 2024. Harish provided additional context about the \$250K defamation suit. He expressed his disappointment about efforts of Hadimani, as past president against VSNA organization. Harish mentioned that many VSNA members are very unhappy. They were so unhappy that during the Atlanta VNSA convention, the general body passed a resolution directing the officers to protect VSNA by expressing trust in VSNA officers. The \$250K penalty demanded by Hadimani translates to 30% of total VSNA funds. Harish mentioned legal fees are high, and legalities are very complex, but we have done everything to defend VSNA and continue to do so. Our lawyers are engaged and exploring all options. They are very efficient and try out all options. Officers will update the board as things develop and unfold.



Houston Chapter: Surplus Funds distributed (\$1,150) to Houston Chapter must be kept in a CD and revenue generated must be used only for Chapter Children Activities, Gift Prices, etc. and must not be used for chapter operating expenses.

We request all the board members to approve the resolution by responding to this email **on or before Friday, Sept 15th 2023, 10PM EST.** Please note that any "Unresponded" vote will be considered as "YES" and hence we kindly request all of you to respond promptly.
