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**CONSENT DECLARATORY JUDGMENT**

This matter having come before the Court on the Plaintiff's Complaint For  
Declaratory Judgment; and it appearing that this lawsuit involves an internal dispute

between members over the results of a 2020 vote to amend the corporate bylaws; and it further appearing that the Plaintiff and Defendant did recount, review and inspect the ballots cast to verify accuracy of the vote and the membership rolls to verify eligibility; and it further appearing that Plaintiff prevailed and was successful in his legal challenge to the voting process; and it further appearing that there was fraud in the tabulation of the ballots; and it further appearing that irregularities in the voting process revealed that the vote was never accurate and that a number of members did not meet the eligibility requirements to vote as required by the Corporate Bylaws; and it further appearing that several violations in the voting process occurred including, but not limited to: a number of people were sent ballots who were not eligible to vote and/or were not paid members according to the time line in the Bylaws; a number of members were improperly sent two ballots; votes from at least 6 deceased members ID's were counted; a number of family members entitled to one vote were improperly sent two ballots; miscalculations occurred in the number of members eligible to vote; and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECLARED, that the 2020 vote to amend the VSNA Corporate Bylaws is invalid in its entirety, without affect, and is hereby set aside.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECLARED, that there is evidence of fraud in the voting process by the "System Administrator", Srishail K. Hadimani, and improprieties in tabulating the vote.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECLARED, that the Plaintiff, GADIGEPPA DODDAMANI, prevailed and was successful in his challenge to the corporate


vote to amend the Bylaws.
